## **Scope of Works**

Everleigh Precinct is a 3,300 lot masterplanned community that covers more than 470 hectares of land at Greenbank. Once completed in 2033, Everleigh Precinct will feature its own collection of community shops, recreational spaces and a new school.

To date, Shadforth have constructed the following at Everleigh Precinct:

- 425,438m<sup>3</sup> Cut to fill
- 46,634m³ Topsoil strip stock pile and respread
- 8,005m<sup>2</sup> Retaining wall consisting of sleepers and concrete panels
- 34,669m<sup>2</sup> Asphalt
- 4,090m Stormwater Various pipe sizes
- 5,619m Sewer Including trunk sewer network, rising main and tankering station
- 3,661m Watermain
- WSUD area Including HES basin, bio basins, drainage channel and low flow/high flow outlets
- Major signalised intersection upgrade Teviot Road / Pub Lane
- Dam Decommissioning Including relocation of turtles, eels and fish.
