Scope of Works

Nestled in Redbank Plains, Eden's Crossing is a 1200-lot residential community featuring 4 large parks, kilometres of hike and bike paths and hectares of beautiful natural bushland.

Shadforth were engaged by the client in October 2018 to carry out Stages 10 - 14 [bulk earthworks package] as well as Stages 10 and 11 (civils packages). Following on from these packages, Shadforth were awarded Stage 13 which comprised of earthworks, roadwork construction, stormwater drainage and water reticulation.

Specifically, the Scope of Works for the above works included:

- 310,000m3 of Cut to Fill
- 6,600m² of pavements
- 1,610m of sewer
- 550m of stormwater
- 850m of watermain
- Preparation of a commercial site

Due to the rapid growth of Eden's Crossing, there was a need to connect Mt Juillerat Drive directly onto Centenary Highway. Shadforth were awarded the contract to carry out works on the following phases:

Phase 2B Roadworks and Earthworks, Drainage, Trunk Water Roadworks and Earthworks, Drainage, Trunk Water Phase 3 Roadworks and Earthworks, Drainage, Trunk Water Phase 4 Link
